Muskoka Algonquin Healthcare (MAHC) provides emergency health care services and inpatient care at two hospital sites in Huntsville and Bracebridge. MAHC serves a catchment area spanning over 4,000 square kilometres, over Muskoka 60,000 residents, doubling that population in the summer months and over 3 million visitors annually. The Huntsville Hospital is located in the town of Huntsville and houses 56 acute care beds, is designated as the District Stroke Centre and is affiliated with the Northern Ontario School of Medicine.

Huntsville Hospital Foundation is the official funding arm of the Huntsville Hospital, and we are about to launch a campaign to support the capital redevelopment of MAHC's, Huntsville Hospital site.
